**60-18 SOUTH RANGE LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF THE FORMER SOUTH RANGE HIGH SCHOOL
MEMORIAL FIELD COMPLEX**

Mrs. Lally moved that the South Range Local Board of Education approve the following:

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the South Range Local School district is the owner of property which is no longer needed for any school purpose, which exceeds \$10,000 in value, which does not include or involve classroom space, and which this Board has determined to offer for sale at public auction pursuant to law;

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Education of South Range Local School District, County of Mahoning, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. It is found and determined that the property described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein which exceeds \$10,000 in value is no longer needed for any school purpose, said property owned by the Board and located in Beaver Township, Mahoning County, Ohio.

SECTION 2. The property shall be sold in the manner provided by Ohio Revised Code Section 3313.41, subject to the terms and conditions provided herein, to the highest bidder after giving at least 30 days' notice of sale by publication in the Youngstown Vindicator.

SECTION 3. The Superintendent and the Treasurer/CFO of the South Range Local School District are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary and consistent with this Resolution to accomplish the sale provided for herein.

SECTION 4. The sale of the property shall be upon the Additional Information and Conditions of Sale set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein, and any other terms and conditions consistent with this Resolution and in the best interests of the Board and District as may be determined by the South Range Superintendent and Treasurer/CFO.

SECTION 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in this Resolution were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.
