Second Grade Supply List for 2019-2020



Dear Parents,

Your child will be entering second grade in a few months! It should prove to be an exciting and challenging year. Let's all team up to make it a most successful experience! With your support, our goals will be achieved.

Over the summer please begin organizing your son/daughter for the beginning of school. The following is a list of supplies needed for second grade:

- **Plain #2 PRESHARPENED** Pencils (at least 48- **no** mechanical pencils and **no** pencil sharpeners, Ticonderoga are preferred) –**PLEASE PLAN TO REPLENISH PENCIL SUPPLY AS NEEDED THROUGHOUT THE YEAR**
- 1 package of pencil top cap erasers
- Glue sticks (16)
- Small liquid glue bottle (1)
- 1 Box of Crayons or Crayola Twistables (*48 or fewer please*)
- 2 highlighters (any color)
- 2 **plastic** folders (**1-red 1-green**)
- 1 single subject spiral bound Notebook
- 4 bold wide dry erase markers
 - **No** regular markers or Sharpies will be needed in 2nd grade
- An old sock (to use as a dry erase eraser)
- Scissors (**Fiskars**)
- One 3 ring 1" **BLACK** binder with clear pocket on the front--VERY IMPORTANT!
- Headphones (Small sized preferred- but not ear buds) in a Ziploc bag labeled with name.
- 1 standard sized school box in which to keep supplies in desk labeled with child's name (Approximately 5 ½ x 8 ½ inches)
- 2 Boxes of tissues
- 1 Container of anti-bacterial wipes (Clorox, Lysol...) **NO Baby wipes**
- Ziploc bags (**Girls bring GALLON size, Boys bring QUART size**)
- 1 set of addition flash cards (Can be found at the Dollar Store)
- 1 set of subtraction flash cards (Can be found at the Dollar Store)
- 1 package of standard size notecards (colored or white)

NO NEED TO LABEL SUPPLIES OTHER THAN HEADPHONES

Pencils, crayons, glue and dry erase markers will most likely need to be replenished throughout the school year. **We suggest that you periodically check with your child concerning these supplies. It would be to your child's advantage if he/she knew all of the addition and subtraction facts to "20" fluently and continued reading during the summer!** Thank you for your cooperation!
